



FOCUS ON HUNGER

Story County has **23 food pantries** currently and numerous food programs.

IN ONE MONTH **6,300 VISITS ARE MADE TO STORY COUNTY PANTRIES.**

The **SHOP** has been a recipient of funds and donations from United Way's annual **LIVE UNITED Food Drive**. ISU staff also participate in **UWSC's Hunger Collaboration** to work together to address hunger in our county.

ISU's student-run pantry, **The SHOP**, housed at 1306 Beyer Hall, served up to 2,200 individuals per month in the recent academic year. In summer 2024 alone (June-August), **The SHOP** had already had 3,814 visits and distributed 42,155 pounds of food.

In the most recent data, ISU students experiencing low to very low food security increased to over 31%*. A survey found over 88% felt **The SHOP** has helped them attend/participate in classes and other campus activities*. *Fall 2021, Spring 2022 respectively
